

- Rules & Safety Pledge**
- Must have valid drivers license.
 - The tractorcade committee suggests you refrain from alcohol while driving your tractor.
 - NO riders unless you have an approved buddy seat and rider has signed waiver.
 - NO passing unless tractor is pulled over and stopped
 - Ride organizers have final say on route, route changes, or roll out due to severe weather, etc
 - All drivers must be 16 years of age.
 - All drivers are responsible for their own insurance
 - All tractors must have a slow moving vehicle emblem
 - All drivers will obey rules of the road and be courteous to other drivers on the road.

I have read and agree to abide by the rules and safety pledge as stated. Violators will be barred from future rides. I understand and acknowledge that the ride organizers, The Keystone Turners and any other participating organizations are not liable for accidents, damages, or actions taken by individual persons during the course of the ride.

This safety pledge must be signed at the time of check in by driver and any rider.

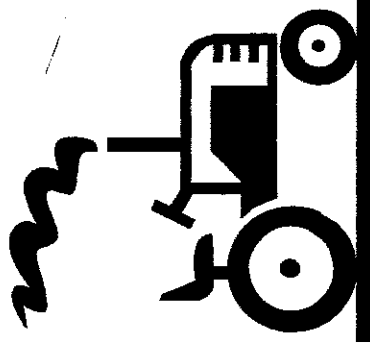
No one will be allowed on ride without signed safety pledge.

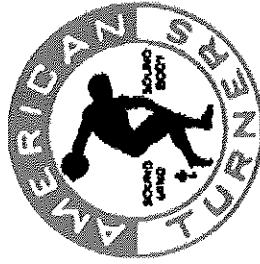

Ride Information

The tractorcade participants should assemble at Sindt's museum at the South end of Main Street. All participants and riders must check in and sign safety pledge. Those not pre-registered will be able to do so 8:00AM to 8:45AM. Those pre-registered can then pick up your packet.

**There will be 2 speed groups:
10-14 mph & 15 mph plus. The slower group leaving first at 9:00**

The Keystone Turners Tractorcade route will be from Keystone south to Luzerne, west to Belle Plaine (there is a 11'6" RR overpass) to the Franklin Park where we will take a 15 - 20 minute break. From Belle Plaine we will proceed west to Chelsea for our lunch break at the Silver Dollar Tavern. Then North to Vining CSA Hall/park for another 15-20 minute break if needed. Then east thru Elberon and on to Keystone. 41 approximate miles.

Note: Tractors can unload at Green Valley Implement if they need a dock. Parking available for trailers in town or at Green Valley.

- Registration begins at 8:00AM to 8:45AM the morning of August 22, 2009.
- There is NO rain date.
- Please come prepared with tools and tow strap or chain in the invent of breakdowns.
- There is an 11' 6" RR overpass on the route from Luzerne to Belle Plaine. Be sure you tractor and any flags or under 11'6".
- Group 1 - 10 - 14 mph will leave at 9:00AM. Group 2 - 15 and over will leave at approx. 9:30AM.
